We agree to supply 2 Span-roofed houses
60ft x 12ft with division in each,
according to enclosed plan, and to
erect same at West Dean Park
in N. D. James Esq

in brickwork, stonework, and cartage from station to be
done at the expense of the proprietor. The buildings to be
constructed of the best Archangel or Petersburg red deal,
seasoned at least two years at our works, and hand-planed
for leaving the machines. The rafters to be grooved on
top to carry all condensed moisture to eaves; and all
surfaces to be properly bevelled both on outside and inside
to prevent wet resting upon them. Sills and plates
to be properly throated. Workwork to be of the following
dimensions, viz: sills out of 7" x 3", plates 5 1/2" x 3",
frames 3" x 1 1/2", lights 2", lantern sides 7" x 1 1/2", door
posts, and rafters, 4 1/2" x 3"; doors to be half glass,
lined and panelled, secured with 1/2" brass butt hinges,
with lock, and F. & P.'s bolts latid. The top and side
ventilation to be opened with our improved simultaneous
apparatus. Workwork to be painted one coat red lead and one
